

BOROONDARA DISABILITY SPORT AND RECREATION HUB



The Boroondara Disability Sport and Recreation Hub developed by the City of Boroondara and the YMCA delivers an array of sport and recreation opportunities for people living with disability in the area. In 2023, the Hub was successfully awarded a \$98k grant through the Together More Active grant funding to continue delivering the established programs and explore opportunities for growth. This project continues to be delivered in collaboration with City of Boroondara, Disability Sport and Recreation and Blind Sport and Recreation Victoria. We are also engaged with program partners Camberwell District Basketball Association and Soft ball Australia.

2023-2025 DELIVERABLES

- Deliver an ongoing schedule of more than 20 hours of weekly disability sport and recreation activities at BLAF facilities
- Deliver a centralized information hub including the development of a Boroondara Disability Sport and Recreation Hub website
- Deliver a celebration event at Boroondara Sports Complex annually to promote diversity and inclusion in our community.
- Deliver come and try days at Boroondara sport complex to promote the sport of Goalball in Boroondara and work with the committee to provide access to suitable facilities in the long term
- Deliver an aquatic based program to support people with vision impairment in accessing suitable aquatic group fitness in Boroondara
- Deliver an annual calendar of community inclusion and diversity education at Boroondara Sports Complex
- Deliver an annual marketing campaign to promote the Boroondara Disability Sport and Recreation Hub.
- Deliver an assessment tool audit of the Boroondara Leisure and Aquatic Facilities to ensure that facilities and staff are as inclusive and accessible as possible.
